The Courses in Commerce were devised in such a manner:

1. To address the recent changes and developments in Business and to educate and endow the students to suit the professional demands of the business world.
2. In order to facilitate the learners to expect the progress linearly through the hierarchy, beginning at "remember" and ending at "create".
3. Due significance were given to incorporate Local, National, Regional and Global developmental needs in the curriculum.

4. The existing courses were updated with spotlight of Employability, Entrepreneurship and Skill development.

The Common Courses offered met the need to sensitize the students by incorporating aspects like Gender, Environment, Sustainable living, Human Values and Professional Ethics in the curriculum.

It was also decided to introduce Extra Credit Massive Open Online Course (MOOC's) in the third semesters.

**After the discussion the following resolutions were taken**

### **B.Com Curriculum**

#### **Semester I**

In order to cover the Section A of the mandatory areas core papers in TANSICHE the Core Course-I, Professional English-I is newly introduced in Semester-I and the syllabus is designed as prescribed by TANSICHE.

The existing course Principles of Accountancy is revised as per the TANSICHE's syllabus with minor changes.

The existing course Business Communication is shifted from Semester II to Semester I and the existing course Business Organisation from the semester-I is removed from the curriculum.

#### **Semester II**

In order to cover the Section A of the mandatory areas core papers in TANSICHE the Core Course-III, Professional English-II is newly introduced as per the syllabus prescribed by TANSICHE.

The existing course Business Accounting from Semester-III is shifted to Semester-II and renamed as Financial Accounting. The syllabus for Financial Accounting-II is revised as per the TANSICHE's syllabus with minor changes.

The existing course Marketing is renamed as Principles of Marketing.

### **Semester III**

The existing course Business Statistics from Semester-II is moved to Semester-III and revised as per the TANSICHE's syllabus with minor changes.

The existing course Principles of Management from Semester-I is shifted to Semester-III and revised as per the TANSICHE's syllabus with minor changes.

In order to cover the Section A of the mandatory areas' core papers in TANSICHE, the course Business Economics is newly introduced in Semester-III as per the syllabus prescribed by TANSICHE with minor changes.

### **Semester IV**

The existing course Business Law from Semester-III is shifted to Semester-IV and revised the syllabus as prescribed by TANSICHE.

The existing course Principles of Insurance from Semester-V is shifted to Semester-IV and revised the syllabus as prescribed by TANSICHE.

In order to cover the Section A of the mandatory areas' core papers in TANSICHE, the course Entrepreneurial Development is newly introduced in Semester-IV as per the syllabus prescribed by TANSICHE with minor changes.

The existing courses from Semester-IV Practical Commerce, Retail Management and Consumer Protection are removed from the revised curriculum.

### **Semester V**

The existing course Office Management from Semester-III is shifted to Semester-V and revised the syllabus with minor changes.

The existing course Computer Application in Business Accounting is renamed as Computer Application in Business.

In order to upgrade the curriculum, the new course Goods and Service Tax is introduced in Semester-V.

The existing course Export Documentation is removed from the revised curriculum.

### **Semester VI**

In order to cover the Section A of the mandatory areas' core papers in TANSICHE, the course Human Resource Management is newly introduced in Semester-VI as per the syllabus prescribed

by TANSCHÉ with minor changes.

The existing course Tally 9.0 is renamed as Accounting Software and revised the syllabus as prescribed by TANSCHÉ with minor changes.

#### Elective Courses:

**It was resolved to introduce further more elective courses options.**

#### Extra Credit Courses

One extra credit Massive Open Online (MOOC's) course will be offered (2 credits). No formal teaching will be made. The students have to study it by self.

Section B 5 X 5 = 25 Marks (Either or)



Section C 3 X 10 = 30 Marks (3 out of 5)






